




MINISTER WELCOME

DIRTNDUST RODEO

Notorious for Australia's toughest conditions, the Julia Creek DirtNDust Rodeo, endorsed by the Australian Professional Rodeo Association (APRA) will have competitors vying for record cash prizes in 2022.

Friday night will see the broncs take to the arena in full flight with the Clonlara Droughtmasters Open Saddle Bronc.

Saturday night the rodeo will open with future champions of professional rodeo in the Mini Bulls event, followed by the crowd stopping Xtreme Bulls Australia with the Rydweld Open Bull Ride in the Mitech Bull Arena, attracting the country's toughest bull riders.


