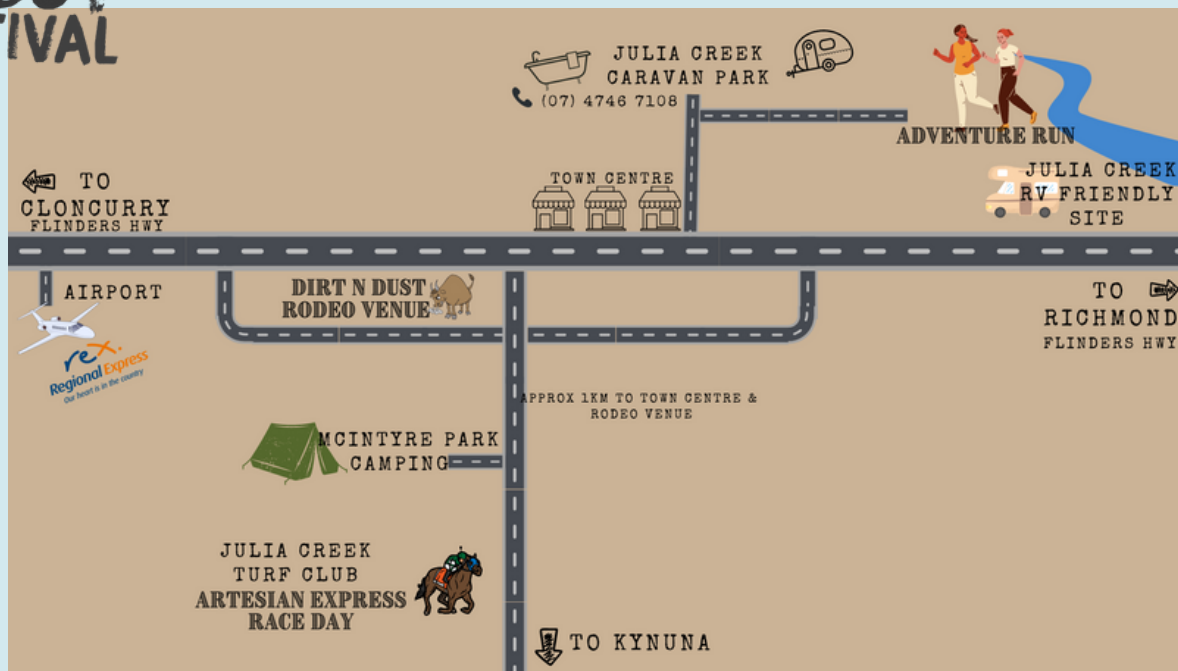


CAMPING AT MCINTYRE PARK FACT SHEET



McIntyre Park is Julia Creek's horse sports complex located just over 1 kilometre from the town centre on the Kynuna Road. It is within the same precinct as the Artesian Express Horse Races. There will be caretakers on site for the weekend.

Arrivals - no sooner than 10am Friday of the Festival. Any sooner is by arrangement with McKinlay Shire Council and within their camping fee arrangement.

Departures - no later than 10am Monday following the Festival. Any later is by arrangement with McKinlay Shire Council and within their camping fee arrangement.

There are toilet and shower facilities available to campers.

Please only camp within the designated areas.

There is a fee to camp here for the Dirt n Dust weekend and sites are strictly limited.

No, this is not the free Julia Creek RV Site nor the Julia Creek Caravan Park (with the artesian bath houses). To book the Caravan Park please call (07) 4746 7108.

Any style of campers - RVs, Caravans, Campervans, Tents and Swags can stay here. All campers are required to be self-sufficient meaning bring your own water and power requirements. **No generators after 10pm.**

Courtesy buses will run all weekend to connect patrons camping at McIntyre Park with the town centre and the Rodeo grounds located on Burke Street.

Be warned, party goers will enjoy a late night or two at this location however, antisocial behaviour and loud music will not be tolerated as you are sharing the site with all-ages and families. The Festival reserves the right to remove unruly patrons.
